ADDITIONAL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Ballet Workshop

(app. 3rd yr and up, ages 8 and up, or by teacher recommendation) - This class is designed for students who have completed 2-3 years of ballet training. This is a fun, comprehensive summer ballet class, focusing on the improvement and strengthening of body placement, flexibility, and overall ballet technique. The Workshop will also introduce other dance disciplines and dance-related subjects, such as French terminology, dance history, pantomime, and modern dance.

Int. Ballet Intensive (with Pre-Pointe/Pointe II)

The Intermediate Ballet Intensive is for students that have completed 4 or more years of ballet training, by teacher recommendation only. Focus is on providing intensive training to develop dance technique in both ballet and modern, while strengthening and improving the dancer's body placement, flexibility, and overall technique. Additional dance-related subjects will also be explored.

Pre-Pointe/Pointe II

Dancers taking the beginning pointe class this past season, will continue with this class as Pointe II for the summer. The other intermediate dancers, not currently on pointe, will take this class as a strengthening pre-pointe class, and will be observed and evaluated throughout the summer, for consideration of placement on pointe in the Fall. Placement in pointe class is at the discretion of the Director. Pointe work is not a consideration until students are at least 11-12 years of age and have had sufficient ballet training to strengthen their feet, ankles, legs, hips, and upper body, and must display significant strength & understanding of both ballet technique and body placement. Students must also be concurrently enrolled in a minimum of 2 intermediate level ballet classes/3 hours per week. Emotional maturity is also considered before placing a student on pointe. Pointe work is hard and beginning pointe classes will be more demanding on the body and feet. Dedication on the part of the dancer to attend class, as well as the support of the dancer's family, is very important toward the success of dancing on pointe. Choosing to dance on pointe is a decision that should be taken seriously.

Advanced Ballet Intensive

Intensive study in classical ballet technique and pointe work and specialty classes (variations, repertoire, turns/leaps, conditioning/stretching, etc). Classes are held 3 days per week, and dancers are required to attend all days.

Modern Dance

Beginning through advanced levels are offered. Classes will focus on an eclectic blend of different styles of modern dance technique. Modern dance itself was first created as a rebellion against ballet and later became a fusion of new expressive ways of moving incorporating technical dance forms. Classes will incorporate technique with a more athletic style of movement including contrace and release, fall and recovery, prances, the fun of improvisation, history of Modern Dance and more! Expression and exploration are key elements that will be included.

Boys Only! Dance Classes

Classes just for boys - No Girls Allowed!! "Bounding Boys" (ages 4-7) offers a creative, athletic experience while developing coordination, dance and motor skills, and rhythm through movement and music. "Athletic Boys Dance" (ages 8-11) offers a unique curriculum of dance training structured to develop strength, flexibility, and coordination along with the discipline, confidence, focus and drive that professional male dancers and athletes have. A variety of dance disciplines will be explored, including hip-hop, jazz, modern, conditioning, and ballet. The focus is on jumps, turns, strength and specific steps and tricks that are unique to male dancers.

❖ DANCE SUN COUNTRY POLICIES:

Current Students

All current students must pay tuition 1 week before session begins to save their class spot. Vacancies may be filled with new students if payment is not received. It is your responsibility to render payment each session if you want your child to continue the class. To ensure your child's spot in classes, consider becoming an Auto-Pay customer for automatic billing.

New Students

Full payment is required with registration. We do not send customers invoices. It is your responsibility to make full payment for each session. Consider becoming an Auto-Pay customer for automatic session billing.

Dropping a Class/Missed Classes

There are no pro-rated refunds or credits for dropped/missed classes. Once the session has begun, you are responsible for attending all scheduled classes during the entire session. Make-up classes must be scheduled through the Sun Country front desk. You must call in any absences prior to the starting of any class. We can not extend a make-up class if no prior notice is given. If a make-up class is scheduled and you fail to attend, you automatically forfeit the class. All make-up classes are your responsibility and may not be carried from one session to the next. If a make-up class cannot be schedule we can offer a free Friday Family Swim.
